Dear brothers and sisters in Christ, Evangelism: one of our ministry goals for this year has been "Everyone disciple someone else this year." Many are now using our discipleship material to evangelize family and friends, so we have seen an increase in

attendance by those who are not born again yet. This is what we have prayed for and it's exciting to see people grow in their knowledge of Jesus, their sin personally toward God, and their need for Jesus as their Savior from God's wrath.
