Thank you for your prayers and much needed financial donations for our critical ministry - we are so grateful for your ongoing love and support.

Support 7 has spent a lot of time in the South Snohomish County community this summer educating folks at public events about our mission: helping

victims and families left behind after tragedies – offering hope and healing. It's so meaningful hearing from the community during these times as they share their own tragedies and losses with us. Praises for these precious opportunities!

All over our nation opioid drug overdoses are on the rise and south Snohomish County is no different - it's a true epidemic. We're serving many families after overdose deaths from ALL walks of life. It's so common now, and extremely sad - many youths know someone close to them who either has an opioid (particularly Fentanyl) addiction, has overdosed, was saved by "Naloxone", or died by overdose. Please pray for wisdom for our leaders in this field and for the hearts and hope of the families devastated in the wake of this drug. NOTE: "Naloxone" or "Narcan" is a medication used in the field by a friend, family member, passerby or first responder the moment someone notices a person may be overdosing. It blocks the effects of the opioids and reverses or reduces the effects of the drug. The nosespray version is now available over the counter and is safe for the public to use. Go to www.stopoverdose.org to receive a free dose of Narcan per month in WA State. This is also a good idea for anyone with elderly loved ones who must take a variety of meds, including pain meds, who may have an unintentional overdose. Finally, please pray for our upcoming 2nd annual conference we're co-facilitating November 3rd on Traumatic Grief Companioning. We trust we get the right people involved and that the light of Jesus is seen by participants from all backgrounds. Any locals interested in joining us?
