UPTOWN KIDS QUESTIONS (LIGHTHOUSE & THRIVE)

1. Jesus told these parables to the grumbling pharisees and teachers of the law while the tax collectors and sinners were gathering around him as well. Why do you think he told these parables to that group of people?

2. How are we "lost" before we trust in Jesus? How are we like the sheep in the story? What does it mean to be lost?

3. In Luke 19:10, it says "the Son of Man has come to seek and save the lost." How does it make you feel that God came looking for you?

4. In John 10:11, Jesus said, "I am the good shepherd. The good shepherd lays down his life for the sheep." What does this verse mean? What did Jesus do for us?

5. What did the shepherd and woman do when they found what was lost?

6. Who rejoices when one sinner turns to Jesus?

7. Did you know that many people in the world are lost and don't even know it? What can we do about that?
