


# DOWNTOWN ZOO QUESTIONS

*After watching our video and reading the provided Bible passage go through these questions as a family. These are great questions to discuss as a family. Don't just have your child answer, answer them together and discuss the lesson.*

1. What did the woman trying to get through the crowd want? Did Jesus help her?
  2. How did Jesus take care of Jairus' family? What was happening with them?
  3. What did we learn about Jesus in both of these stories?
  4. What can you do to show Jesus' love to someone in your family?
- . Is there someone you know who is sick? What can you do to help care for them? Pray for them as a family.

## UPTOWN KIDS QUESTIONS (LIGHTHOUSE & THRIVE)

1. This woman interrupted Jesus on his way to Jairus' daughter. This delayed him. Did Jesus get bothered by the interruption? Does He get bothered by us when we pray to Him?
2. The woman was sick and suffering for many years. What are some problems we have that we cannot fix? What problems did Jesus fix for us?
3. After the woman had been immediately healed, Jesus felt the power go out of him and he looked into the crowd and asked, "Who touched Me?" What did the woman do then? Jesus already knew the answer to this question, he knew everything about this woman even before she was born, so why do you think he would ask this question?
4. Jesus said to the woman: "Daughter your faith has healed you. Go in peace and be freed from your suffering." Like the woman who touched Jesus robe, when we place our faith in Jesus, we are immediately healed from what?
5. Jairus and the woman both believed Jesus could heal. How were their actions similar? How were they different?
6. When everyone felt the situation was hopeless with the little girl, Jesus said, "Don't be afraid, just believe" How can we have hope when things seem hopeless? What does Jesus tell us to do?
