


Spot 8 differences between the two pictures.

DOWNTOWN ZOO QUESTIONS

After watching our video and reading the provided Bible passage go through these questions as a family. These are great questions to discuss as a family. Don't just have your child answer, answer them together and discuss the lesson.

1. What would it be like if your legs really didn't work? Would life be difficult? Imagine how the man in our story felt.
2. Where did Jesus go in our story? Who did he talk to at the pool?
3. What did the man think Jesus might do for him?
4. Why was Jesus able to heal the man? What does this story tell us about Jesus?

UPTOWN KIDS QUESTIONS (LIGHTHOUSE & THRIVE)

1. Where was Jesus when He saw the man who could not walk? Why was the man there?
2. Why did Jesus heal the man who was lame? Did the man ask to be healed?
3. Why were the religious leaders upset at the man who had been healed?
4. How are we similar to the man who could not walk? (Guide family to discuss that fact that we are helplessly trapped in sin).
5. How can we gain salvation and healing from sin? How does Jesus give hope to sinners?
6. What do Jesus' healing miracles teach us about God's kingdom?
