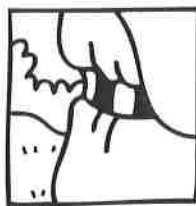




STORY POINT: **JESUS TAUGHT PEOPLE HOW TO PRAY.**

# DOWNTOWN ZOO QUESTIONS

1. Do you pray to God? Where are some places that you pray? What do you pray about?
2. When Jesus was teaching how to pray, what did He say we should ask God for each day?
3. Why did Jesus say the friend would help his neighbor even late at night? Would God help you if you prayed late at night?
4. Is there something you need to pray and ask Jesus about right now? Talk as a family and create a prayer plan. Talk about the different types of things to pray for your needs, others needs, forgiveness, thankfulness.

5. Can you think of a time you prayed for something specific? What happened?
6. What are some things that you are praying about right now? Is there anything you should start praying about?
7. What does this lesson teach me about God, Jesus, the Holy Spirit, or the gospel?
