


Use the pictures and words to fill in the squares.

 Our Bible says, "Hear the word of God and obey it" (Luke 11:28).




Draw a picture of yourself running, jumping or hopping.

DOWNTOWN ZOO QUESTIONS

After watching our video and reading the provided Bible passage go through these questions as a family. These are great questions to discuss as a family. Don't just have your child answer, answer them together and discuss the lesson.

1. What would your life be like if you couldn't walk? Would it be hard? How would you feel?
2. In our story today, what did the lame man ask Peter and John to give him? What was their response?
3. Who made the man's legs strong so he could walk again? What did he do once his legs were strong?
4. Is there someone in your life who might need some help right now? What are some ways you can show them God's power through helping them?

UPTOWN KIDS QUESTIONS (LIGHTHOUSE & THRIVE)

1. What did the man at the gate ask for from Peter and John? What did they give him?
2. What did the religious leaders tell Peter and John to stop doing? Did they listen?
3. Do you think it is important to tell people about Jesus? What about helping them with their problems?
4. Who is someone that you can share Jesus with right now?
5. Is there something that might be stopping you from sharing about Jesus? What is it? What can you learn from today's lesson to remove that thing from hindering you from sharing the gospel?
6. What did the man do once he realized he could walk again? How did it make him feel?
7. Is there something in your life that you can rejoice and thank the Lord for?

***In Jesus' name, Peter healed a man who could not walk. Remember, the man wasn't healed because Peter was a super believer. Peter explained that it was by Jesus' power the man was healed.**
