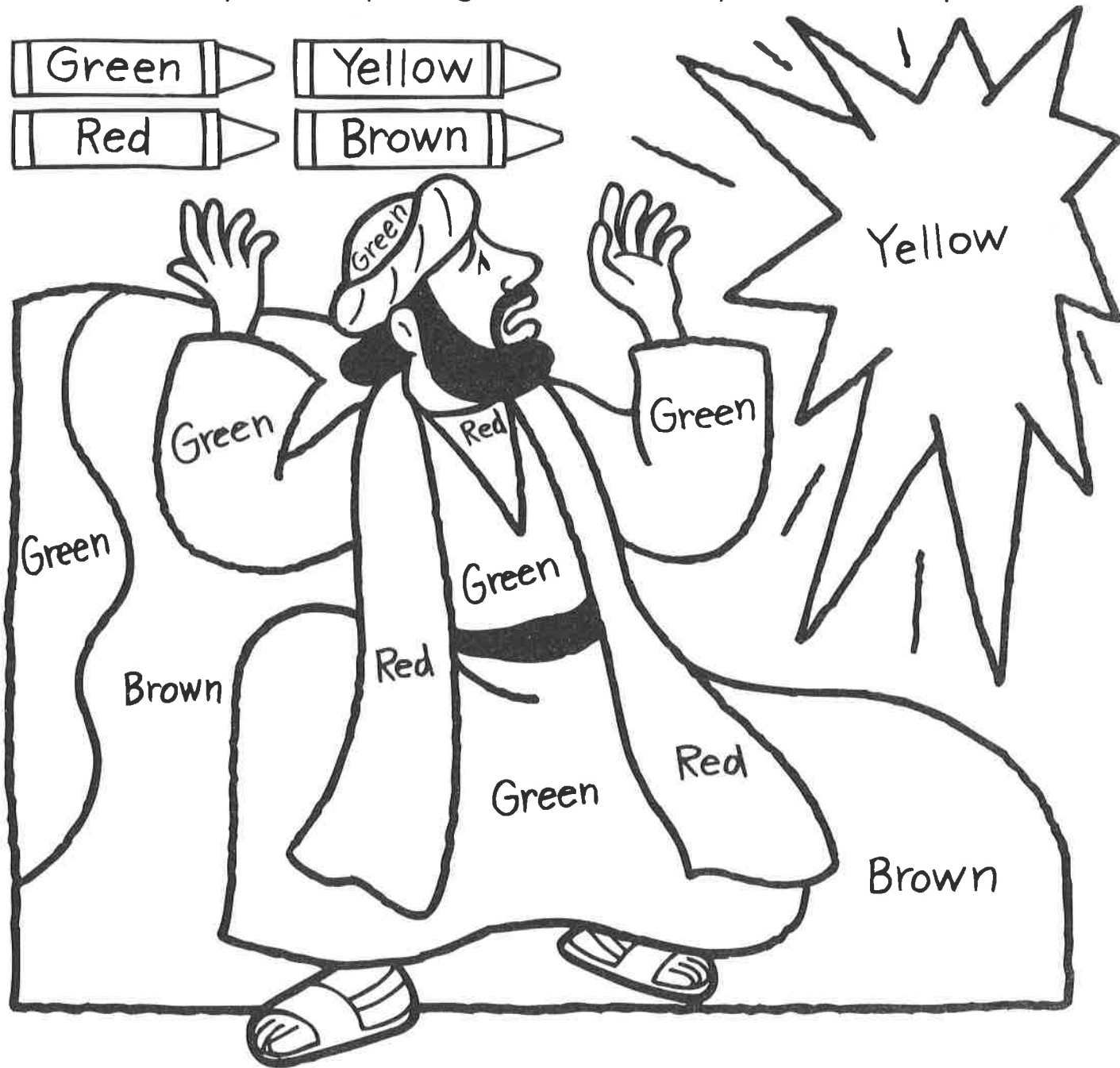
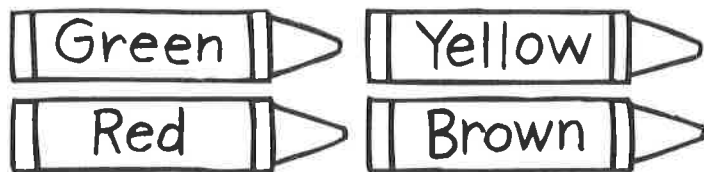


**MAIN POINT: JESUS SAVED SAUL FROM HIS SINS AND

Then color the picture by using the correct crayon for each space.



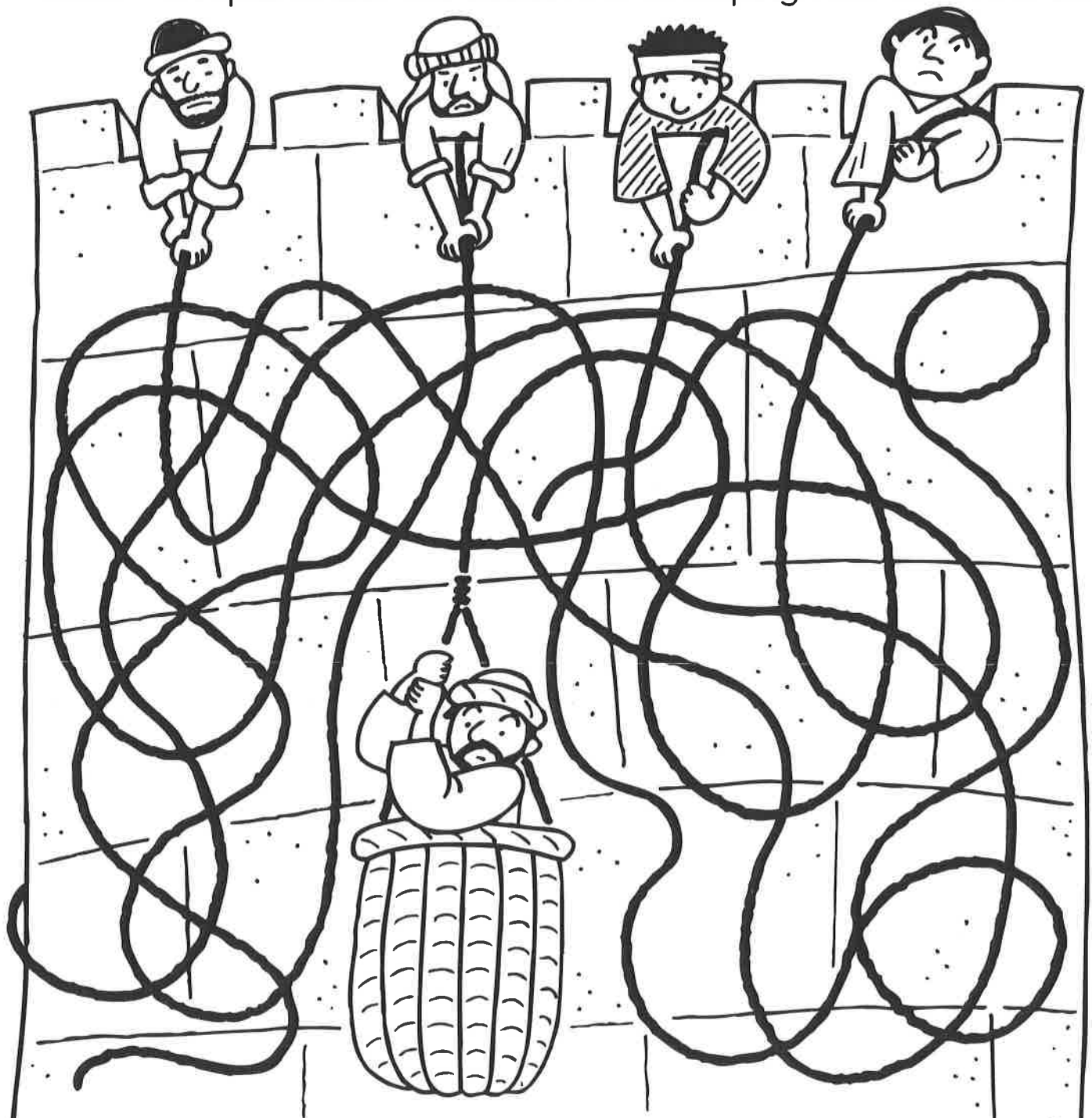
God showed love for Paul when He helped Paul learn that Jesus is God's Son.

1. Why was Saul going to Damascus?
2. What happened when Jesus spoke to Saul?
3. Who did Jesus send to help Saul? What did he do?
4. What evidence do we see that proves that Saul was changed? What evidence is there in your life that shows that you are a follower of Jesus?
5. Who was Saul's first Christian friend? How can we be a friend to someone who is a new Christian?
6. Some people thought Saul was too evil to change. Did God think that? What happened between Saul and God?
7. Is anything too hard for God? Is anyone too evil to be changed by His grace?
