






Look at the pictures of Paul and Silas singing in jail.

3. What wonderful things has God made that you can sing and tell about?
4. What did Paul and Silas tell the jailer he had to do to be saved? (Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved – Acts 16:31). Do you believe?

## UPTOWN KIDS QUESTIONS (LIGHTHOUSE & THRIVE)

1. Why did Paul and Silas go to the river? Who was there?
2. What happened to Lydia and her household? Why is it important as a Christian to be baptized?
3. How did the servant girl make money for her owners? What did Paul and Silas do for the servant girl? Were her owners happy about it? Why or why not?
4. What were Paul and Silas doing while they were in prison? If you were in prison, do you think you would be singing and praising God? Why or why not?
5. What caused the prison doors to open and the prisoners' chains to come loose?
6. What did Paul and Silas tell the jailer he had to do to be saved? (Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved – Acts 16:31). Do you believe? Is there someone else you can share the Good News with?
7. What can you learn from the people in this story? (Lydia, the servant girl, Paul, Silas)

*\*Lydia, the jailer, and many others were saved because they heard the gospel and believed in Jesus. Paul and Silas preached the same message to all people, no matter who they were: "Believe in the Lord Jesus and you will be saved."*
