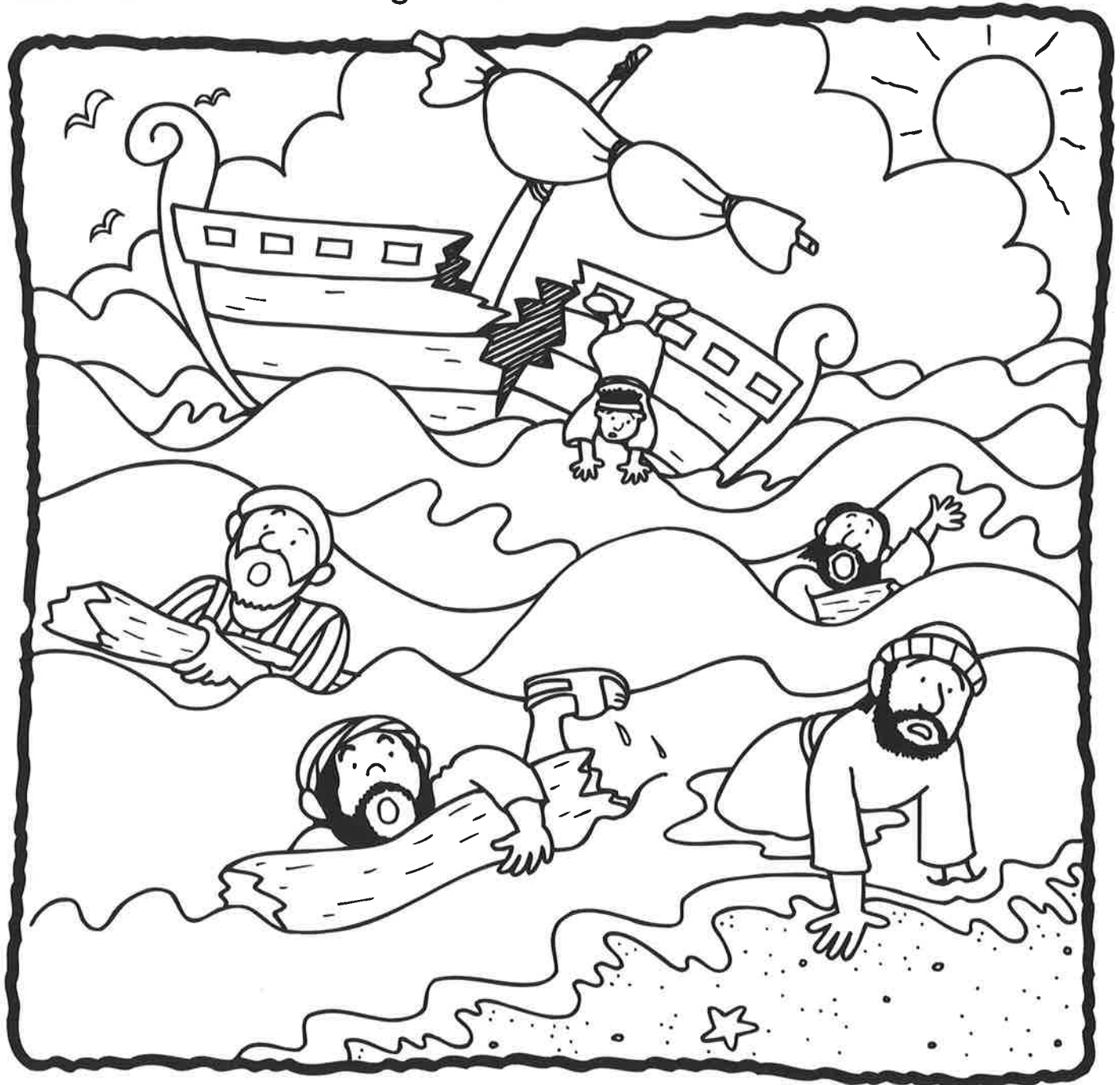


Paul's ship wrecks in a storm.

There are at least 6 things to color.



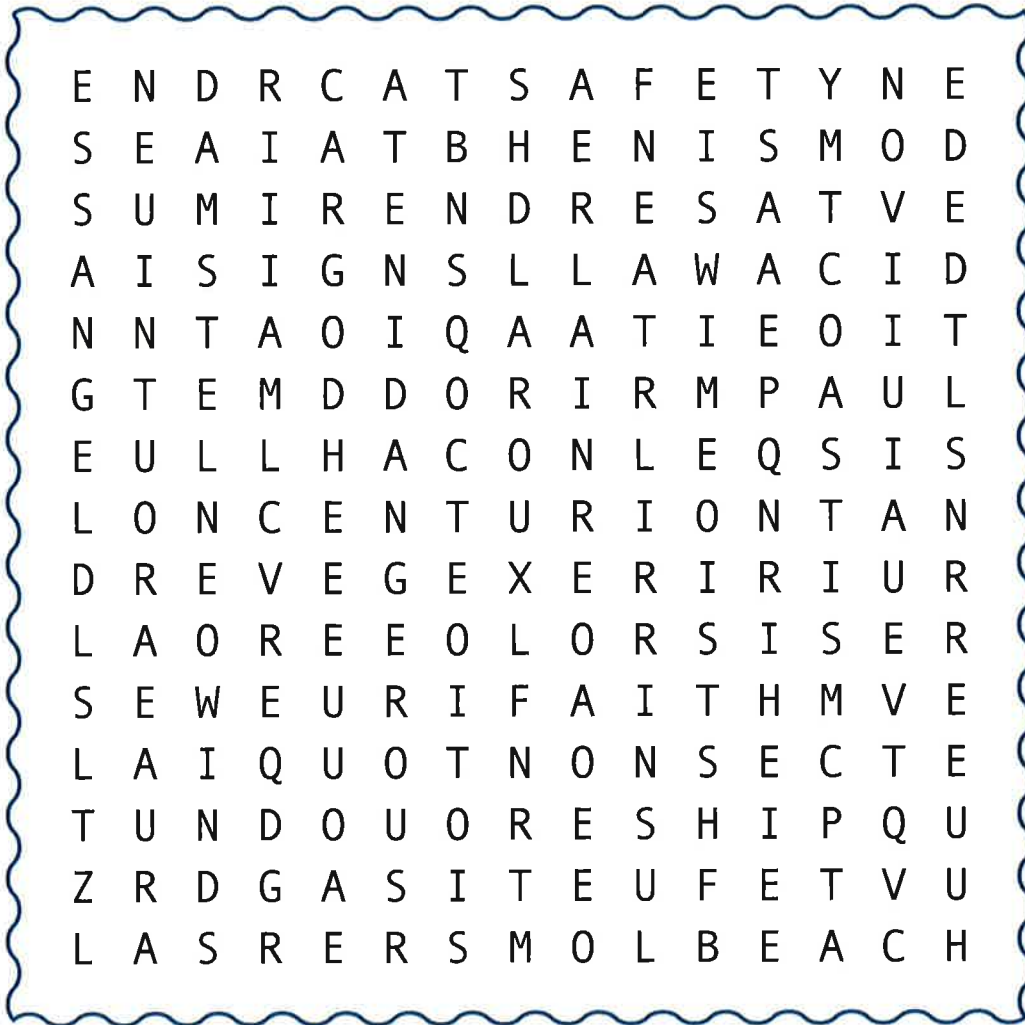
Paul showed God's love to his friends in a shipwreck.
