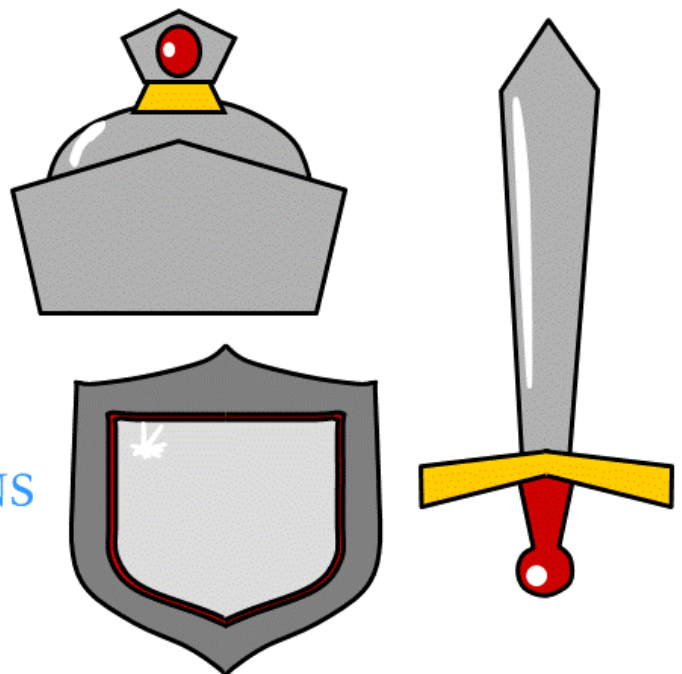

3. What does this armor protect us against?

6. The armor of God is not physical armor, so how do we prepare ourselves for that battle?
