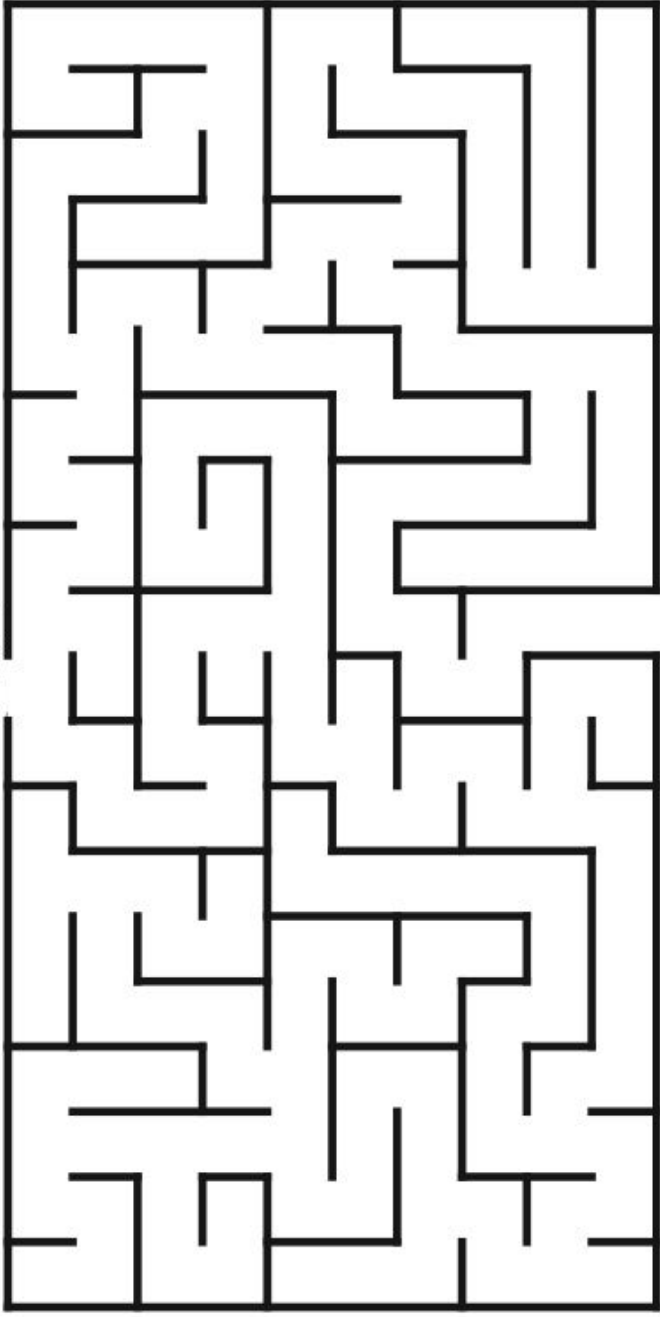

After watching our video and reading the provided Bible passage go through these questions as a family. These are great questions to discuss as a family. Don't just have your child answer, answer them together and discuss the lesson.

What did Peter ask Jesus?

Who did not forgive in the story?

How often do you think Jesus wants us to forgive?

What does it mean to forgive? Were you ever mad at someone? Did you forgive that person?

Who has forgiven you for something? What did it feel like to know you were forgiven?

LIGHTHOUSE/ THRIVE FAMILY QUESTIONS

Why did Jesus tell Peter to forgive 70 x 7? What did that mean?

How did the king treat the servant who owed 10,000 talents? (Matt 18:27)

How did the servant treat the man who owed him 100 denarii? (Matt. 18:30) Why does this part of the story shock us?

What did the king do when he heard what the servant had done? (Matt. 18:32-34)

Who are we most like in the parable? Who is God most like?

What does this parable teach us about forgiveness? (Matthew 6:14)

Is it hard for you to forgive? Have you every been like the unforgiving servant and not forgive someone you should? Have you seen unforgiveness?

Why is it especially important for family members to forgive one another? (Eph. 4:31-32) What is the relationship between love and forgiveness? Is it hard for you?
