


DOWNTOWN ZOO FAMILY QUESTIONS

After watching our video and reading the provided Bible passage go through these questions as a family. These are great questions to discuss as a family. Don't just have your child answer, answer them together and discuss the lesson.

- *Who was Jesus talking with in our story? What kind of questions did he have?
- *Who do you go to when you have an important question about something?
- *Jesus said that He had been sent by God not to punish the world but to do what?
- *What does it mean to be born again? (this can be a hard question for preschoolers, but process the gospel message as a family, and what it means to be saved, this is a great opportunity to share your own testimony of how you found Jesus and were born again).

LIGHTHOUSE FAMILY QUESTIONS

- *Jesus said that He had been sent by God not to condemn the world, but to do what? (John 3:17)
- *What does it mean to be born again?
- *What does it mean to have eternal life?
- *Why did God send Jesus to save us? Who can be saved? (Romans 10:13)

THRIVE FAMILY QUESTIONS

- *What was so unusual about Nicodemus coming to Jesus? (he did so at night, and he was a religious leader with lots of knowledge)
- *What does it mean to know a lot **about** the Bible without really knowing the Bible? (it's important to understand and follow it)
- *Why did Nicodemus need to be rescued? Why do you think we chose that word to focus on this week?
- *The Israelites couldn't help themselves in the Old Testament story of the snakes (Num. 21:4-9). They had to look on the bronze snake lifted on a pole to be healed. What/Who saves us?
- *What does it mean to be born again? Are you born again?
