

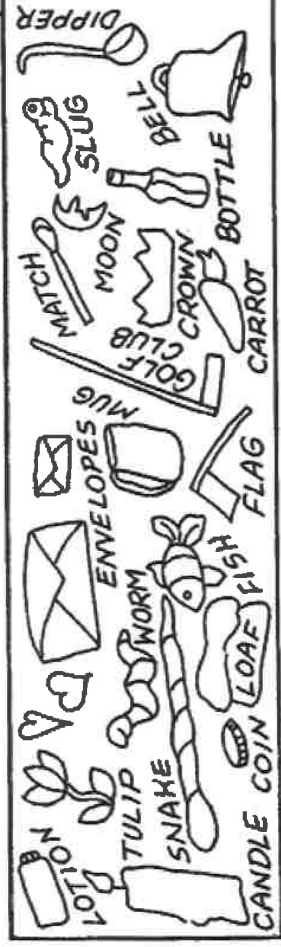

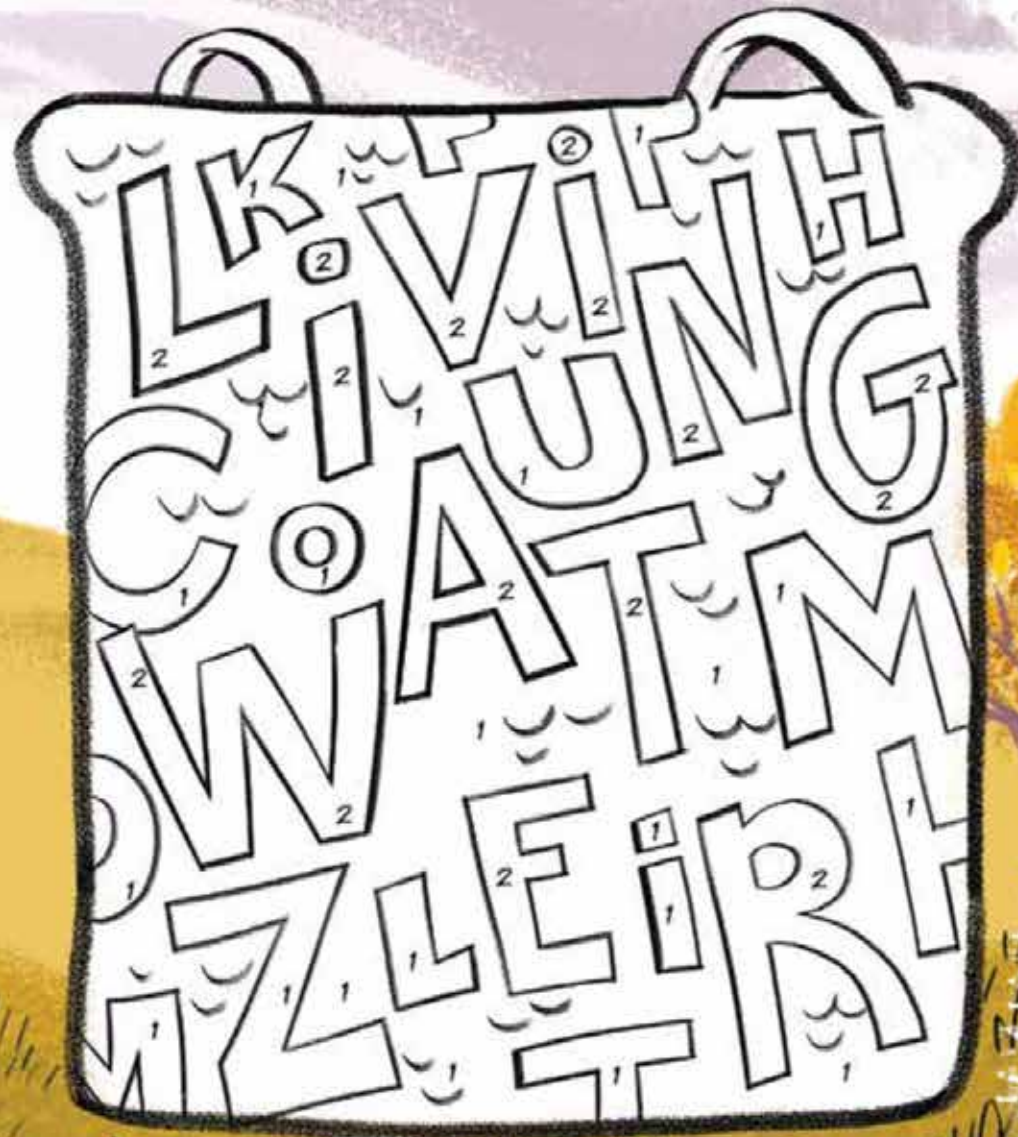
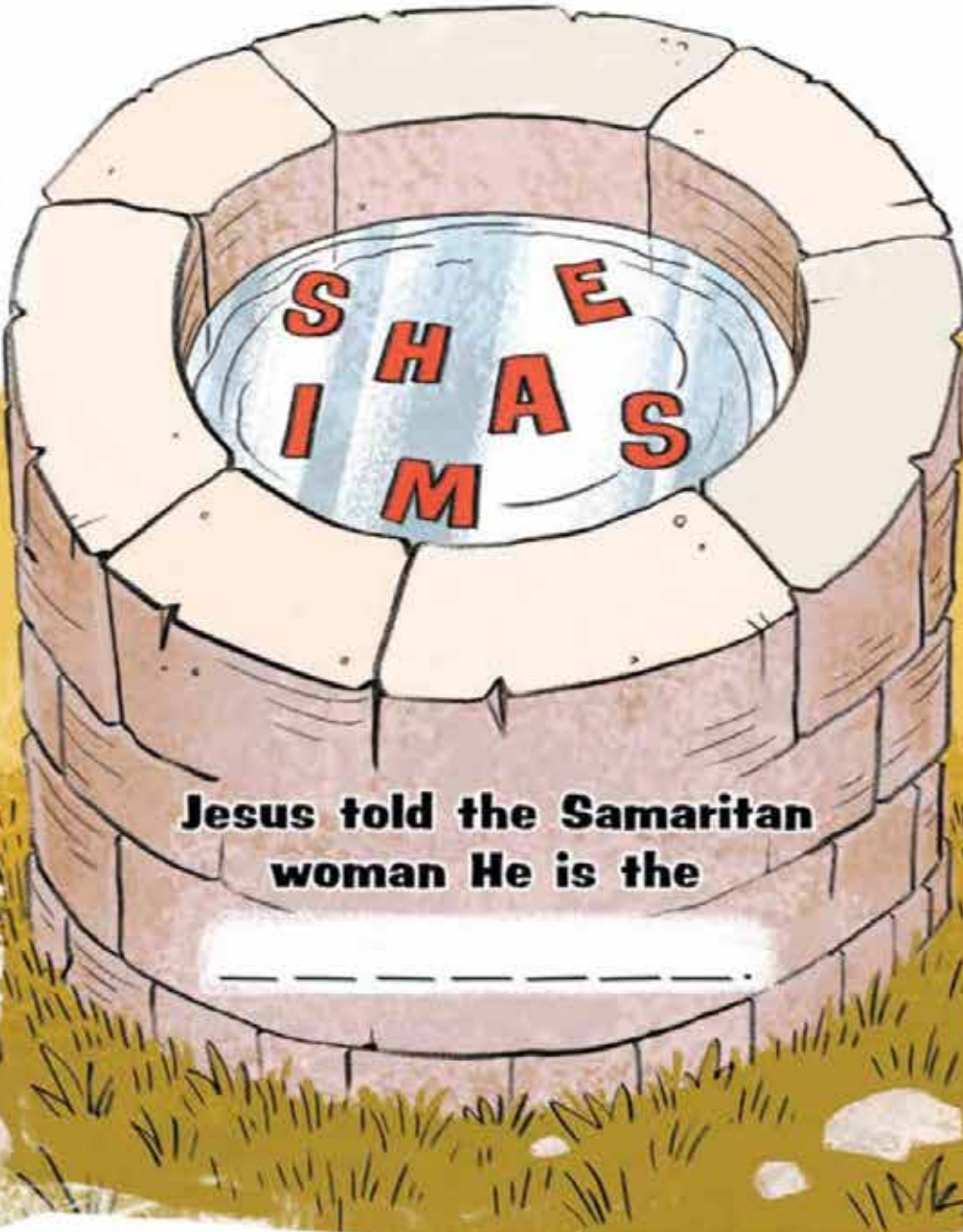
Find the hidden pictures above in the puzzle.

DOWNTOWN ZOO FAMILY QUESTIONS

After watching our video and reading the provided Bible passage go through these questions as a family. These are great questions to discuss as a family. Don't just have your child answer, answer them together and discuss the lesson.

- *What did the woman come to the well to get? What did Jesus say to the woman?
- *The woman was trying to get water from the well. What are some ways that you get water?
- *What did Jesus tell the woman about Himself? (I am the One God promised to send)
- *Jesus showed the woman He loved her by telling her about God. What are some ways that Jesus shows He loves you?

LIGHTHOUSE FAMILY QUESTIONS

- *What did Jesus say would happen to a person who drinks the living water? (John 4:14)
- *What is the living water Jesus spoke about? (The living water is a picture of what the Holy Spirit is like. When we believe the gospel, Jesus sends the Holy Spirit to live within us. He helps us to love and obey God and fills our lives with joy and love so that we can “overflow” joy and love onto other people.)
- *How does your physical need for water help you understand your spiritual need for Jesus?
- *How can we receive “living water”?
- *Why is sharing your testimony important?

THRIVE FAMILY QUESTIONS

- *Did Jesus have to travel through Samaria to get to Galilee? How did Jews usually travel from Judea to Galilee? What does this tell us about His choice to go through there?
- *How does Jesus treat the Samaritan woman? She was at the well at noon, one of the hottest parts of the day. What does this tell us about her being there at that time when the other women would already have gone? How should we treat people like her?
- *Who in your life can you be a friend to and maybe even share the gospel with that you wouldn't normally consider a friend?
- *What does Jesus say about the living water that is different from the water this woman is used to drinking?
