


Follow the maze through the tree.



DOWNTOWN ZOO FAMILY QUESTIONS

After watching our video and reading the provided Bible passage go through these questions as a family. These are great questions to discuss as a family. Don't just have your child answer, answer them together and discuss the lesson.

Why didn't people like Zacchaeus?

What did Jesus do to show love to Zacchaeus? What are some ways that Jesus shows love to you?

What did Jesus say to Zacchaeus?

What did Zacchaeus say to show he was sorry for doing wrong? Did Jesus forgive Zacchaeus? Will Jesus forgive you when you do things wrong?

LIGHTHOUSE/ THRIVE FAMILY QUESTIONS

What was Zacchaeus's job? (chief tax collector, Luke 19:2)

What did Zacchaeus climb to see Jesus? (a sycamore tree, Luke 19:4) Where did Jesus tell Zacchaeus He was going to stay? (at Zacchaeus's house, Luke 19:5)

Why were the other people upset that Jesus was staying with Zacchaeus? (Zacchaeus was a sinner, Luke 19:6)

How much of his possessions did Zacchaeus offer to give to the poor? (half, Luke 19:8) How does this show a changed heart? What can you do as a family this week to show Jesus that you love Him?

Jesus knew Zachhaeus' name. He knows your name too and everything about you. He came to seek and save you! Are you seeking Jesus? Have you let him into your heart? Has your life been changed by Him?

Zacchaeus was disliked by the people. Are there jobs now that might make people dislike you for doing? Is it fair to judge a person by his/her job?

Zacchaeus repented and put his desire to obey into action by giving money back to those he cheated. Where in our lives do we need to make changes in order to follow Jesus better?
