

Hidden Pictures: The Birth of John the Baptist

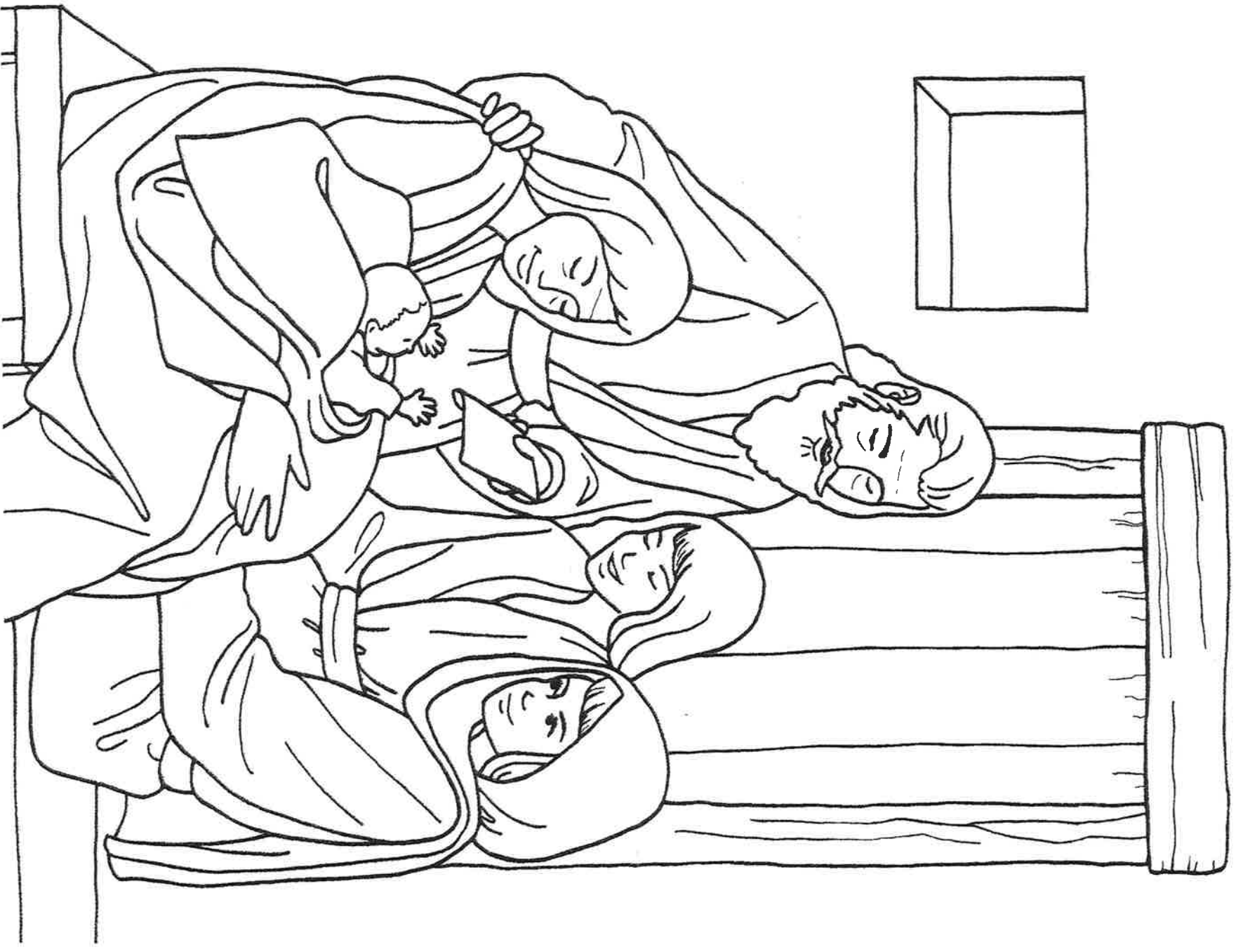
Find these objects hidden in the picture below: book, cake, fish, football, magnet, moon, needle and thread, snail, sock, spoon, sherrif's badge, star.

DOWNTOWN ZOO FAMILY QUESTIONS

After watching our video and reading the provided Bible passage, go through these questions as a family. Don't just have your child answer, answer them together and discuss the lesson. You can even act it out as a family!

- 1 What did God do for Elizabeth and Zechariah? (He blessed them with a baby to be named John.)
- 2 If you had been one of the relatives or friends, how would you have shown joy about their baby?
- 3 At first Zechariah didn't believe the angel! Do you think it's important to believe what God/the Bible says? Why or why not?
- 4 What do you know about God that helps you to believe His promises?

LIGHTHOUSE FAMILY QUESTIONS

- 1 Where did Zechariah work? How often did he get to go inside to offer incense? (temple, this was his 1st time)
- 2 What happened while Zechariah was in the temple? What was Gabriel's message? (an angel appeared; God was going to give them a son)
- 3 Why did Gabriel say Zechariah would be silent? (He didn't believe Gabriel's message)
- 4 One of God's promises to us is that He would never leave us or forsake us. What does that look like to you?
- 5 How often should followers of Jesus read, study, and obey God's Word?

THRIVE FAMILY QUESTIONS

- 1 What were the first words the angel spoke to Zechariah?
- 2 Would you find it hard to believe a message brought to you by an angel? Do you find it hard to believe the promises in the Bible? (for example, Jesus' return) What steps can we take to help us believe God's promises?
- 3 The name 'John' means "the Lord is gracious." Where do you see God's grace in this story? In your own life?
- 4 How can we be ready for Jesus to return some day? How can we help others? Are you doing these things?
- 5 John's mother was a descendant of Aaron. As a family, share what you know about your own family history. Does anyone else in your family follow Jesus? Who can you be praying for that they would come to know our Savior?
