Sermon questions

1. Where do you see God at work in the first two chapters of Esther?
2. Have someone read **Esther 2:5-11**. Esther is likely a young teenager. Put yourself in her shoes. How would being in a situation like hers affect your view of God?
3. Have someone read Romans **8:28-31**. How do we understand the truth of **Romans 8:28** in the context of trials and suffering like Esther experiences in these chapters? In what situations in your life do you need to apply this promise from God?

4. Have someone read **John 14:27** and someone read **16:33**. What is unique about the peace that Jesus offers us? What are some ways that you can **go** and offer the peace of Jesus to people in the midst of our turbulent culture?

5. What are some of the non-obvious ways God might be at work in your life and our world right now? How can you **grow** in being someone who sees the way God is at work in your life?
