Sermon questions

We're in a series celebrating ACC's 100th birthday this month! We're taking three weeks to look at God's faithfulness to our church over the past century, God's mission for us today, and where God is taking us in the future.

Use these questions to discuss the message from Sunday, focusing on how you can **grow** as an everyday follower of Jesus and how you can **go** accomplish what Jesus calls you to do.

1. In what ways has God used the local church in your life to help you **grow** as a follower of Jesus? Who specifically did God use?
2. Have someone read **Ephesians 4:11-16**. From your experience, how is ACC doing in fulfilling the purposes laid out in vv. **12** and **13**?
3. Vs. **16** makes it clear that every part of the church has a role to play, including you! What is your role right now in accomplishing the purposes of the church from question 2?

4. Pastor Wyatt referenced the way that Jesus both claims to be the light of the world and tells His followers that they are the light of the world (**John 8:12** and **Matthew 5:14**). How can you **go** and join in as a part of ACC's role to be the light of Jesus to the world around us?

5. Reflect on the current season we are living through. What unique opportunities does the local church in our community have right now to display the light of Jesus in our dark world?
