Big Idea: Every day is divine.

Sermon Questions

This Sunday is an ASM (Alderwood Student Ministry) service. We'll be hearing from Pastor Curtis as he teaches from the book of *Ruth*. The Big Idea for this message is: *Every day is divine*.

Use these questions to discuss the message from Sunday, focusing on how you can **grow** as an everyday follower of Jesus and how you can **go** accomplish what Jesus calls you to do.

1. Read **Ruth 1:1-17**. What is so compelling about Ruth's response to Naomi's urging for Ruth to return to Moab and her own people?
2. In **Chapter 2**, Boaz takes notice of Ruth gleaning in his fields. Read **Ruth 2:6, 11-12**. What does this interaction tell us about Ruth's character and her devotion to God?

3. Ruth ultimately ends up marrying Boaz, and we find out an interesting piece of information about the offspring of this marriage in **Ruth 4:17**. What is the importance of this family line, and how does it impact us today considering what we know about Jesus?
4. Ruth is faithful both to her relationship to Naomi and her devotion to the Lord as we find in **Chapter 1**. It is through a seemingly small decision to stay with her mother-in-law that the whole course of this story hinges upon. What does faithfulness in everyday decisions teach us as we consider how to **grow** in our own walk with Christ?
5. Considering how Jesus' mission for his followers is one of global impact (**Matthew 28.19-10**), how can we **go** each and every day through faithful decision making?
