Message questions

We're beginning our year of growing in our love of Jesus and the Scriptures. The first series in our year-long journey through God's Story is called *Building Blocks*. We are studying five big themes in the beginning of the Bible to give us some foundation we need to understand more of who Jesus is and where he is leading us today. This week, our passage is **2 Timothy 3:14-17**, and we learn that the Scriptures are able to give us wisdom for salvation through faith in Jesus.

Use these questions to discuss the message from Sunday, focusing on how you can **grow** as an everyday follower of Jesus and how you can **go** accomplish what Jesus calls you to do.

1. The Bible is one big story that fits together to help us understand God and how we can experience life with Christ. What is your history with the Bible? How has it been frustrating or intimidating in the past?
2. Have someone read **vs. 14-15**. What does it mean when the author says, "from infancy"? How can we continue in what we have learned together?

3. Read **vs. 16-17**. How do these verses impact your desire to better understand God's Story?
4. How are you hoping to **grow** this year as we go through God's Story together?
5. Who first introduced you to Jesus? Who are you praying for that you can **go** and represent Jesus to the world around you?
