Message questions

Throughout this series, we will be highlighting Jesus in the Old Testament.

This week, our Old Testament passages are **Genesis 1:26-28**; **Exodus 20:1-17**;

32:1-6. The New Testament passages are **Colossians 1:15** and **Romans 8:29**.

The Big Idea this week is *Jesus fulfills humanity's purpose as the true image of God*.

Use these questions to discuss the message from Sunday, focusing on how you can **grow** as an everyday follower of Jesus and how you can **go** accomplish what Jesus calls you to do.

1. Read **Genesis 1:24-28**. What difference do you see between wildlife and mankind? What do these differences tell us about God?
2. Read **Exodus 20:4**. How is this commandment different from the previous commandment in **vs. 3**?
3. Have someone read **Colossians 1:15-20**. What do we learn about who Jesus is and his role in the purpose of life and its meaning?

4. Jesus is the true image of God who empowers us to image God like we were made to do. Share amongst your group how you can best image God to **grow** together as an everyday follower of Jesus.

5. What situations or relationships are you in where the only Jesus the people around you see is YOU. How can you **go** towards them in a meaningful way this week? Spend some time praying for these relationships and situations.
