Big Idea: The kingship of Jesus is a reality that turns the world upside down.

Acts 17:2-3

The decision that Jesus is king changes all other decisions.

If Jesus is king, your enemy is not your enemy.

Matthew 5:43-44

If Jesus is king, status is upside down.

John 13:14-15

If Jesus is king, right and wrong is objective.

3. Now have someone read **Acts 17:6-9**. Based on what you have seen so far in the book of Acts, how had the Christian movement been turning the world "upside down"? What was the message that Paul was being accused of proclaiming? Why do you think it was problematic for that time and place?

4. Pastor Wyatt said that if Jesus is king, then Caesar is not — and you are not. What areas of your life do you need to **grow** in your trust in Jesus as king? Where do you need to submit to King Jesus right now? What are tangible things you can do this week in those areas?

5. How is Jesus calling you to **go** this week and proclaim the message of his rule and reign as king? Who in your life needs to hear this message?
