### **MISSIONARY UPDATE** →Wilson & Cora Ladringan Aeta Children's Home, Philippines

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ at ACC, Shalom!

First, please allow us to extend to all of you our heartfelt gratitude and sincerest appreciation for all your faithful prayers and support to the Lord's work here in the Philippines, particularly to the tribal Aeta people.

The Aeta tribe is one of the unreached people here in the Philippines. They are short, kinky haired, animistic people who live in the mountainous areas of our province here in Zambales. They are the poorest among the poor. They survive by hunting and food gathering. They are also very discriminated against and most neglected people of our country today. We are sharing with them the Good News of Salvation through faith in our Lord Jesus Christ. We do this not just in words but most of all, in good deeds and actions. By God's help and grace, we are doing the following ministries for the Aetas:

- 1. Providing free Christian education to the Aeta children from kindergarten to high school. Please pray for additional classrooms and teachers in the Christian school.
- Providing them free medical service through our medical clinic. Please pray for medical supplies.
- 3. Planting new churches in their villages. We have planted 15 Aeta churches in the villages. Please pray for our Aeta pastors.

Please pray for our VISION 2025, that is, to double the number of these Aeta churches by the year 2025. Please pray for our feeding project for the malnourished children, as well as the skills training for the Aeta youth. Please pray for the supply of foods and vitamins for these poor, but precious, children. Please pray for our medical mission in the villages of the Aetas. Many are sick and in need of medical help. Please pray for medical supplies. Please pray for the *Retreat, Refuge, and Rest Center* for the hurting and depressed Aeta women and children. Please pray that we can build the facilities for this Retreat Center. The Lord has provided the land where we can build this center.

Thank you very much. God richly bless you for your faithful partnership and friendship in the Lord's work here in the Philippines.
