MISSIONARY UPDATE

→ Cory & Kristine Cramer Thrive International Missions, Albania To our Alderwood Family.

Greetings from Albania! I trust you are reading this preparing to worship this Sunday, and I pray today you are blessed by the love of God, fellowship of the saints, and the power of Christ. Our mission is to strengthen the church of Albania, a nation where less than 1% of people know Christ. We work strategically to reach Albanians with the gospel, to disciple them, train them and equip them. This is not only our mission, but it is yours as well. You have sent us and we are rejoicing for the countless lives impacted by the work of the gospel. As we wrap up a long winter (heard you had a rough one too...) please know we are blessed in our ministry. It feels every day Albanians grow in their faith. In different ministries we have groups studying Acts, Romans, Daniel, 1 Peter, James and 1 John. People are hungry for God's Word!

Our church building is in the middle of a massive renovation. Cement, scaffolding, and bricks are everywhere. We are going to move in to this location, whether it's ready or not, in April. We plan to have a special service of dedication for this new location. I wish you could see the impacts this church space will have on the countless lives of Albanians.

Finally we have baby Emiliano growing in our home. This baby was abandoned in the hospital weighing three pounds. His mother did not eat, wrapped her stomach and as a result he was born small with deformed hands. Somehow the Lord brought us into the situation. Kristine and I heard that the orphanage refused to take him because of his hands, and so we had to respond. We have three kids already... what's one more?? Now we have found a great, godly couple from America who are in the process of adopting Emiliano.

This is where you need to pray. The process of his adoption has reached a point where the Albanian government is in control. As of right now we have not heard any news for a month in regard to his case. Would you pray? Pray as you drive home, pray tonight with your family for this baby boy.

The reality is God gave him broken hands, so that he

would be placed in a home with parents who love Jesus. It's a beautiful story, but it's not over yet. We


