Hello Alderwood family,

Greetings from Kenya. We are so excited to celebrate with you our recent return to East Africa. As we enter into seven years of serving with you in South Sudan we are very humbled at the way your congregation has so lovingly prayed for and supported us. This past home assignment was a very difficult one with many medical challenges and unknowns for our family and your prayer support and loving notes of encouragement truly blessed us. Thank you.

As we settle into life here in Kenya we are filled with anticipation to see what God will do. Jonathan is helping to lead a security training to help folks be better prepared to serve in their unique contexts and he is also preparing to hold some "stakeholders meetings" with the South Sudan church to get buy-in and input as the water project becomes self sustaining. He is excited to see the work his water team has done in South Sudan in his absence and encourage them in the Word of God.

Jonathan is also beginning to lead Bible study with a group of youth from South Sudan. Amie continues her role of chaplaincy/pastoral care and homeschooling the kiddos.

As you read this we are getting ready to celebrate our first week in Kenya. It has been good to be home and while most of our time has been spent unpacking our home and resettling we have enjoyed sweet moments with teammates and friends and are anticipating what God will do in this next season here.
