Sermon Questions:

1. Read **Mark 3:21 and 3:31**. Then read **Luke 1:30-38**. What do you suppose happened to Mary's view of Jesus between these two moments?

Do you have moments where you doubt Jesus?

2. Jesus' family is telling Him He is crazy in verse **21**. How do you maintain humility and respond when you've had accusations that are false and hurtful from those you love?
3. Read **Mark 3:35**. You are either in God's family or you aren't. Doing God's will is one way we know we are in His family. How do you know you are doing God's will?
4. By living like we belong to God's family, we will be an example of what His family looks like. How can you live in a way that is attractive to others outside the family of God so they want to be a member of His family?

5. What would be true of a kingdom where the king viewed his subjects as his brother and mother?
6. Maybe you have earthly family members that aren't members of God's family. How do you maintain and honor your earthly family, while still placing your identity in the primary relationship with God's family first?
