

	Sermon Questions:
1.	Is there really evil in the world? Do you think Satan is a real being? If so, how does he do his work today?
2.	Read Mark 5:1-8. How bad off was this man?



5.	What do you think was the man's attitude and outlook as he went home to tell his friends and family about what Jesus had done for him?
	What's your attitude when you talk about Jesus? Do you tell people what He has done in your life? What do you say?
6.	Where do you think the disciples were when all this was going on? How do you think they reacted? Do you think they asked something similar to the question in Mark 4:41 ?
7.	This passage teaches that Jesus has the power to save anyone, even someone who is as enslaved as this man was. Can you think of anyone who seems to you to be beyond Jesus' ability to save? Why do you think that? When will you start believing Jesus can save them, and pray for that person?
