Colossians 1:1-2 *Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God, and Timothy our brother,* ²*To the holy and faithful brothers in Christ at Colosse: Grace and peace to you from God our Father.*

- I. HONOR YOUR <u>KING</u>!—Verse 1 Paul, an apostle of Christ Jesus by the will of God,
 - A. The <u>Reason</u> for Honor
 - 1. The Knight's Oath of Fealty-- "I promise on my faith that I will in the future be faithful to the lord, never cause him harm and will observe my homage to him completely against all persons in good faith and without deceit."¹
 - 2. Why does King Jesus deserve that kind of devotion from us?
 - 3. No other book of the Bible has a more majestic description of Jesus Christ than this little letter.
 - B. The <u>Behaviors</u> of Honor
 - 1. Make Jesus your number one <u>study</u>.
 - Colossians 2:2-3 My purpose is...that they may have the full riches of complete understanding, in order that they may know the mystery of God, namely, Christ, ³ in whom are hidden all the treasures of wisdom and knowledge.
 - J. I. Packer—Well might God say through Jeremiah, "Let him that glories glory in this, that he understands and knows me"—for knowing God is a relationship calculated to thrill a person's heart.²
 - 2. Make Jesus your number one <u>employer</u>.
 - Colossians 3:17 And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus...
 - **Colossians 3:23-24** Whatever you do, work at it with all your heart, as **working for the Lord**, not for men, ²⁴ since you know that you will receive an inheritance from the Lord as a reward. It is the Lord Christ you are serving.
 - 3. Make Jesus your number one <u>audience</u>.
 - **Colossians 1:10** *live a life worthy of the Lord and...please him in every way: bearing fruit in every good work...*
- II. LINK ARMS WITH YOUR FELLOW <u>KNIGHTS</u>!—Verse 1 ...and Timothy our brother

No man in the New Testament made fiercer enemies, but few men in the world have had better friends. They cluster around him so thickly that we are apt to lose their personality in their devotion.-- Harrington C. Lees

- A. <u>Why</u> We Need Significant Relationships
 - 1. Because No One of Us Has It <u>All Together</u>
 - Colossians 4:10-11 My fellow prisoner Aristarchus sends you his greetings, as does Mark, the cousin of Barnabas. (You have received instructions about him; if he comes to you, welcome him.) ¹¹ Jesus, who is called Justus, also sends greetings. These are the only Jews among my fellow workers for the kingdom of God, and they have proved a comfort to me.
 - 2. Because We All Need Somebody Praying for Us
 - Colossians 4:3 And pray for us, too, that God may open a door for our message, so that we may proclaim the mystery of Christ, for which I am in chains.
 - Colossians 4:12-13 *Epaphras...is always wrestling in prayer for you*, that you may stand firm in all the will of God, mature and fully assured.
- B. How God Wants Us to Build Significant Friendships
 - 1. Build friendship around a transcendent cause.

- 2. Build friendships to "Go the Distance"
 - KJV Colossians 2:2 That their hearts might be comforted, being <u>knit together</u> in love...
 - Colossians 4:9 Onesimus, our faithful and dear brother. Philemon 1:12 I am sending himwho is my very heart-- back to you. Philemon 1:16 He is very dear to me

III. SHARPEN YOUR <u>WARRIOR SOUL</u>!—Verse 2 To the holy and faithful brothers in Christ at Colosse

- A. We Need Strength-Building for the War <u>Out There!</u>
 - **Colossians 1:11** being strengthened with all power according to his glorious might so that you may have great endurance and patience...
 - Colossians 2:7 rooted and built up in him, strengthened in the faith as you were taught...
 - **Colossians 1:24** Now I rejoice in what was suffered for you, and I fill up in my flesh what is still lacking in regard to Christ's afflictions, for the sake of his body, which is the church.
- B. We Need Strength-Building for the War In Here!
 - Colossians 3:12-14 Therefore, as God's chosen people, holy and dearly loved, clothe yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience. ¹³ Bear with each other and forgive whatever grievances you may have against one another. Forgive as the Lord forgave you. ¹⁴ And over all these <u>virtues</u> put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity.
