MISSIONARY UPDATE

RYAN AND DIANA CLEVELAND CRU

Dear Alderwood Family,
As you read this, I am in Wenatchee at a weekend retreat for local ROTC cadets and midshipmen. This is my second year getting to participate in this retreat, and I am excited to see what the Lord is going to do in the lives of these men and women as they seek to walk with and serve the Lord! Please pray that the Lord would greatly impact the lives of the cadets and midshipmen at the retreat and that they would be a light for His Kingdom on their campuses as well as in military service. But that is just one weekend on a very exciting, but busy school year. Just a few months in to the school year, the HR Director that was overseeing much of the old Northwest region, resigned from Cru to follow the Lord to an Executive Pastor position at a church in Eugene, OR. Already being familiar with much of his area, I was asked to help fill in on an interim basis. That area includes the eastern halves of Washington and Oregon, Alaska, Idaho, Montana, Utah, Wyoming, Colorado, New Mexico, and El Paso. This is in addition to my role as the HR Director for Cru's Valor ministry. While it certainly has been super busy (17 out of town trips this school year), the Lord has continued to do amazing things in our midst in the campus ministry of Cru.

Diana continues to see the Lord at work in the lives of immigrants, internationals, and refugees in our community. Currently, she is looking at how the Lord might use her more effectively as she explores how to use neighborhood-based language training to meet a tangible need in the community, that would lead to more opportunities to see the Gospel shared with people that do not know the Lord. It has been an amazing experience to have Bible studies where people are all reading the Word in their own language and discussing it in English.

The kids are doing well and are very involved in ASM Middle School (Abby) and Thrive (Josh). It is really exciting to see them continue to grow in the Lord here at ACC!

As always, we are continually grateful for being a part of what the Lord is doing in the world through ACC!
