**Big Idea: Jesus is the king that no one expects but everyone needs.**

### **Sermon Questions:**

1. The sermon text Sunday morning described Jesus' "Triumphal Entry" into Jerusalem, seven short days before His crucifixion. If you were planning a "triumphal entry" for Jesus today, what would it be like?
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
  
2. Read **Luke 19:28-34**. What do you think is happening here? Do you think Jesus prepared ahead to borrow the donkey prior to sending the disciples? Or, was this a miracle?

What do you think the disciples were thinking as they went on this mission to find the young donkey for Jesus?

3. Read **Luke 19:35-38**. What was Jesus proclaiming about Himself by the way He entered Jerusalem (read **Zechariah 9:9**)?

Compare **Psalm 118:26** with **Luke 19:38**. Do you notice anything different? What do you think is significant about the change?

4. How did people respond to Jesus' "triumphal entry" into Jerusalem? How did Jesus respond to each of them? How do people today respond to the truth that Jesus is King of Kings? How do you?

5. After all the resistance Jesus received from the Jews, how do you account for **Luke 19:41**? What does this say about Jesus? Does this portray a different view of Jesus than what people have today?

6. What was Jesus telling the Pharisees in **vv.42-44**?

7. Read **Luke 19:42**. What does it mean to you to miss peace with God? Do you know anyone who is missing out on peace with God? How can you help them understand the peace God offers?
