	Life Group Questions
1.	Read <b>Mark 14:12-16</b> . List the activities that had to be done before Jesus and the disciples could eat their Passover meal.
2.	Jesus inaugurated a new way that was not part of the Jewish system (see <b>Jeremiah 31:31-34</b> ). Why then, did He go to so much trouble to celebrate the Passover with His disciples?
	John the Baptist called Jesus the Lamb of God ( <b>John 1:29, 36</b> ). What is the meaning of the phrase "Lamb of God"?

	How does this meaning tie in with Mark 14:12-26?
3.	Imagine yourself in that upper room with Jesus "reclining at the table eating" (v.18). What would be your reaction to Jesus' words in vv.18-24?
	Read <b>Mark 14:21</b> again. If the Son of Man will go "just as it has been written "how could Judas have been held responsible and accountable?
4.	What promise did Jesus make to His disciples in <b>Mark 14:25</b> ?
	What is the significance of this promise to you?

5.	Read <b>Mark 14:22-25</b> and <b>Luke 22:19</b> . What are you actually doing when you take communion?
	Why does Jesus command you to take communion?
	What happens in your life when you forget who Jesus is, who you are, and what He did for you?
6.	Pastor Curtis taught us why communion is so critically important. What did he say that helped build and solidify communion's meaning for you, or gave you new insights into its significance? Explain.
