Big Idea: For everyday followers, Jesus is everything

We all betray Jesus, so we all need his sacrifice

Communion links the past, present, and future

Communion is personal and communal

How does this meaning tie in with **Mark 14:12-26**?

3. Imagine yourself in that upper room with Jesus “reclining at the table eating” (v.18). What would be your reaction to Jesus’ words in vv.18-24?

Read **Mark 14:21** again. If the Son of Man will go “just as it has been written” how could Judas have been held responsible and accountable?

4. What promise did Jesus make to His disciples in **Mark 14:25**?

What is the significance of this promise to you?

5. Read **Mark 14:22-25** and **Luke 22:19**. What are you actually doing when you take communion?

Why does Jesus *command* you to take communion?

What happens in your life when you forget who Jesus is, who you are, and what He did for you?

6. Pastor Curtis taught us why communion is so critically important. What did he say that helped build and solidify communion's meaning for you, or gave you new insights into its significance? Explain.
